PREFACE

This guide to the literature is intended as an introductory reading-list on Modern Syria for a newcomer to the subject. It is by no means exhaustive, but aims to cover material in the principal European languages such as will provide good background knowledge of the country since World War I.

There is a large number of general works available which deal with the Whole Middle East, and only a brief general reference section is therefore included.

Considerable space is devoted to the political struggles of the Mandate period, as it was deemed important for an understanding of subsequent events. Attention is also given to the various ethnic and religious minorities who have been a fundamental cause of political difficulties throughout the period covered. Large sections cover material dealing with political, social and economic development of Syria.

Much has had to be omitted owing to lack of space, and difficulties in obtaining material. It is hoped, however, that this compilation of approximately 950 items will provide a useful working bibliography.

All references have been carefully checked, either by originals or the National Union Catalogue.

I would like to make acknowledgement to Miss M.E. Sales, whose own research provided the basis for this work, to the Staff of Durham University Library, and to Miss Avril Yeates who typed it.
